This comprehensive policy empowers the Office of the National Security Adviser (ONSA) and the Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC) with expanded authority, enabling them to treat any interference with these systems as acts of economic sabotage.

For the technology, media, and telecommunications (TMT) industry, this designation fosters a more secure environment conducive to the expansion of Nigeria's 90,000 km fiber-optic backbone.
